Dear friends,

In this rapidly changing world, we see the need to connect to the message of the Gospel and express our faith to others in a new, more real way for everyday life. At times it seems that, as beautiful as it is, the content of our faith is "up there" in the clouds. In life we deal with real problems which require real answers. How can we bring faith, God, the resurrection, the victory of Christ over death down to our day-to-day life? When, for instance, there is a crisis in the marriage, or a relationship becomes painful; when we get a serious sickness, or we experience loneliness, or we feel misunderstood, not properly appreciated; when the working environment -- or even the family environment-- feels toxic, how can we experience that the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the answer to these situations of life? Furthermore, even people who have had a true experience of faith sometimes see that the way they try to express the importance of faith to those who are close to them and to their children or grandchildren does not manage to reach their heart and to speak to their lives.

At St. Anthony and St. Joseph's Churches we are addressing this issue with a Catechesis, a series of meetings, which will put us in touch with the proclamation of the Good News, of the forgiveness of God, and of the victory of Christ over death, going to the original proclamation from the time of the Apostles -- of the primitive Church.
