THE BISHOP'S CORNER

My Dear Fellow-Catholics

I want to share with you two news items that affect our Diocese. After several years our Diocese has another candidate for the priesthood. Mr. Stephen Notman, 37 years old and from St. Michael's Parish has, after a long discernment, decided to enter a formation programme towards the Sacrament of Holy Orders. I see this as a sign of blessing in such troubled times for Catholic clergy. I decided to send Stephen to Rome where he will attend a four-year formation programme in Philosophy and Theology at St. Bede English College which offers a very accurate programme for his type of vocation. I studied in Rome myself and found it a unique opportunity to grow in the spirit of our Church. Please pray for Stephen as he continues his journey of discernment. Please, also, continue to pray for new Bermudian vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

It is going to be a financial challenge for our Diocese, as it is for every family when they send their children to university. Bishop Robert Kurtz, in his wisdom and hope, set up a special fund for the support of theological training. However, in order not to drain this fund completely, I dare to ask for your possible assistance in financing Stephen's formation in Rome.

And here is the second announcement. At the last meeting of the Diocesan Finance Council I was advised that the best time for the Annual Bishop's Appeal is February and March. Since we are already in September, I resolved that there would be no Bishop's Appeal this year. We will be promoting the next Annual Bishop's Appeal at the beginning of 2019.

However, if you would like to support our Diocese for this year in addition to your ordinary support, I ask you to consider two possible objectives:

1. Studies in Rome of our seminarian, Stephen Notman.

2. Our Youth participation at the Steubenville Conference that our Diocese substantially supported this year and will do the same next year.
