PASTOR'S NOTE

Dear friends, as we commemorate the entrance of Jesus in Jerusalem and meditate on the passion of Our Lord, we need to be reminded that Palm Sunday for Christians was not a sad day. In fact it was the day when those who would become Christians at Easter were making their solemn public profession of faith and received the palm of victory, a very meaningful sign that was reminding that becoming a Christian most likely would end up in martyrdom. Christians then celebrated with joy this day ideally entering into Jerusalem with Jesus in order to be introduced with him to the heavenly Jerusalem of heaven. This year we have a special circumstance that is that the eve of the Jewish Passover coincides with our Good Friday.
